CoCounsel is able to respond in seconds to natural language instructions and read, comprehend, and write at a postgraduate level. CoCounsel automates critical, time-intensive legal tasks and produces top-quality work more quickly, accurately, and precisely than humanly possible. Casetext announced recently that CoCounsel is powered by GPT-4, the latest, most advanced large language model from OpenAI. GPT-4 recently passed a simulated version of the bar exam, ranking among the 10% of human test takers.

Attorneys at the Employment Law Center of Maryland assisted Casetext in developing CoCounsel during its beta phase by rigorously testing the tool, and providing feedback to Casetext.
